Terms and Conditions for Sponsorship at Mekaela Academies

- In order to qualify for a sponsorship, parents/guardians must give their detailed background and the reason for their application in writing.
- Information must be accurate. Giving false information will disqualify parents or guardians from participation in the sponsorship programme. Mekaela Academies reserves the right to seek a refund for sponsorships obtained under false pretences.
- Digital information and communication is essential for the schools' and operations and its means to acquire sponsorships. Parents/guardians agree that photos and videos of, as well as information and data about them and their spouses may be collected, saved and processed digitally and published on the internet and/or sent to the sponsors of a child.
- Only needy families may qualify for sponsorship. If the economic situation of a family should later improve it is expected that the sponsorship will be returned and made available to less fortunate families.
- The parents/guardians will make sure that the child can reach the school, and return home safely.
- At home, the child must be supported and encouraged with its studies. For its studies, the child must be provided with sufficient space and time.
- The parents/guardians are responsible for the cleanliness and the orderliness of the child's school books, uniforms and shoes. Books and other working materials which are used by the child are to be kept in good condition. Every book must be wrapped into a protective cover. Every child is an ambassador of its school, it is expected that the child's appearance is appropriate.
- It is expected that parents/guardians of sponsored children offer voluntary services to the school. In every term, one parent/guardian should be available for one half day to render his/her services to the school on the headmaster's request. Such services are to be provided for no other than the school's benefit.
- To keep a good communication with the sponsors, they receive copies of school reports and at least one letter of the sponsored child every year. The parents/guardians will be held responsible for the timely delivery of those items to the school's administration. Failure to comply with this rule may cause the termination of the sponsorship.
- It is expected from a sponsored child to perform well at school. If the average score of the school reports for three consecutive terms stands below 50%, the sponsorship may be reviewed for termination.
- All grievances must be reported in writing by letter or email to: msaada@mekaela.com giving the child's name, its student number and the name of its school. It will not be accepted if complaints are directed at your sponsors without having submitted a written report to the school.
- The disposition of a sponsorship lies within the discretion of the sponsors only. It does not constitute a right for the beneficiary; it is neither claimable nor transferable and may be revoked without notice if the Terms and Conditions are not met.
- By signing this form you confirm that you have read, understood and accepted the Terms and Conditions for Sponsorship and that you realise that not complying with them may lead to a termination of the sponsorship.
